# Finding the Truth: Understanding the Bible

## The Law

### **Purpose:**

God's gift to his people to establish their relationship with Him and their relationship with each other. In addition, boundaries were set for their relationships with surrounding culture.

## Law In Scripture

- 1. Laws (plural) 600+ commandments the Israelites were expected to keep. (Exodus 18:20)
- 2. Law (singular) reference to all the laws collectively. (Matthew 5:18)
- 3. The Book of the Law (singular) referring to the Pentateuch Genesis to Deuteronomy. (Joshua 1:8)
- 4. New Testament reference meaning the entire Old Testament religious system. (1Corinthians 9:20)
- 5. Old Testament referenced in New Testament as the interpretation of the rabbis. (Acts 10:28)

#### The Old Covenant

#### Written in the form of a "suzerain" treaty

- 1. Preamble: identifies the parties. (Exodus 20:2)
- 2. Prologue: brief history of how the parties came to be connected. (Exodus 20:2)
- 3. Stipulations: individual laws.
- 4. Witnesses: those who will enforce the covenant (Deuteronomy 4:26, 30:19)
- 5. Sanctions: Blessings and cursing's (Leviticus 26, Deuteronomy 28-33)
- 6. Document closure: provision for review (Deuteronomy 17:18-19; 31:9-13)

## Relationship of the Old Covenant to the New Covenant

- The Old Testament pointed to Jesus
- Understanding the law in relationship to Jesus
  - a. Those laws "fulfilled" in Jesus (sacrifice, priesthood, worship, Sabbath, etc.)
  - b. Those laws continued in New Testament (moral law)
  - c. Those laws abrogated in New Testament (dietary, circumcision)
  - d. Laws located in cultural times

#### The Form of the Law

- It sets a standard, by example, rather than mentioning every possible circumstance (paradigmatic)
- Apodictic Law
- · Casuistic Law
