### Nature of the Epistle:

- Letters to individuals or churches.
- They address specific occasions or concerns.
- They are all from the first century.

- Second Missionary Journey: 51-53 AD
  - o 1st Thessalonians: 52 AD
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> Thessalonians: 52 AD
- Third Missionary Journey
  - o 1st Corinthians: 57 AD
  - o 2nd Corinthians: 57 AD
  - o Galatians: 55-57 AD
  - o Romans: 57-58 AD
- Imprisonment in Rome: 61-63 AD
  - o Ephesians: 62 AD
  - o Philippians: 62 AD
  - o Colossians: 62 AD
  - o Philemon: 63 AD
- Post imprisonment journeys: 63-67 AD
  - o Titus 64-65 AD
  - o 1st Timothy: 64-65 AD
  - o 2nd Timothy: 67 AD

#### Understanding the Epistles

- The text cannot mean what it could never have meant to its author or readers.
- When our situation is comparable to the 1<sup>st</sup> century situation God's word is still the same to us as it was to them.
- For those situations culturally determined, the principle behind the action must be gleaned.
